# CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING GOLF CART PARADE

## SAFETY PLAN

---

### I INITIAL RALLY POINT

All golf carts participating shall be brought to the Public safety building before sunset.

Golf carts located on the east side of Mexico Beach may use city streets to drive their carts to the Public Safety building.

Golf carts will NOT be allowed access on Highway 98 before or after the parade.

The line-up will be:

Lead: MBPD Police Unit

Middle: Golf Carts

Rear: MBVFD Fire Engine 2

### II, Route (approximately six to seven minutes in length)

MBPD Police static road blocks at eastside of the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> Street and the west side of 19<sup>th</sup> Street. The route will start at 14<sup>th</sup> Street and end at Sunset Park.

All vehicles and carts will remain in the westbound lane until arriving at Sunset Park. The vehicles will come to a stop in the eastbound lane until Santa Claus has arrived.

Upon the arrival of Santa Claus, all vehicles and carts must pull on to the right-of-way area and clear of any traffic on Highway 98.

### III. RETURN

Highway 98 will be open for traffic for 10 minutes.

After 10 minutes, Highway 98 will be closed while golf carts are lined up.

The golf carts will be escorted back to the Public Safety building by a MBPD Police unit. All golf carts will return at the same time.

All vehicles will remain in the eastbound lane until turning onto 14<sup>th</sup> Street.

## **ATTACHMENT**

**Florida Statute 316.193** Driving under the influence; penalties.-

- (1) A person is guilty of the offense of driving under the influence and is subject to punishment as provided in subsection (2) if the person is driving or in actual physical control of a vehicle within this state and:
  - (a) The person is under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance set forth in s.877.111, or any substance controlled under chapter 893, when affected to the extent that the person's normal faculties are impaired;
  - (b) The person has a blood-alcohol level of 0.08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood; or
  - (c) The person has a breath-alcohol level of 0.08 or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath.

**Florida Statute 316.1936**(2) (a) It is unlawful and punishable as provided in this section for any person to possess an open container of an alcoholic beverage or consume an alcoholic beverage while operating a vehicle in the state or while a passenger in or on a vehicle being operating in the state.

(b) It is unlawful and punishable as provided in this section for any person to possess an open container of an alcoholic beverage or consume an alcoholic beverage while seated in or on a motor vehicle that is parked or stopped within a road as defined in this section. Notwithstanding the prohibition contained in this section, passengers in vehicles designed, maintained, and used primarily for the transportation of persons for compensation and in motor homes are exempt.
