Rain or Shine

Regulations:

- Hours of operation will be 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. Central Time.
- Vendors will park and unload in designated areas as directed, or marked by event personnel.
- Vendors must be set up and be ready for market opening at 9 a.m.
- Spaces (10 x 10) will be rented on a first come first served basis. Market fee of \$10 per space must be paid prior to setup.
- Space fees may be waived at the discretion of event personnel for non-profit groups.
- Vendors will supply their own tables, tents, or other supplies needed for the space.
- **Following items are eligible for sale:**
Fresh produce, dried fruit and nuts, plants and flowers, honey, fresh baked goods (following the Cottage Law and labeled a “Made in a cottage food operation that is not subject to Florida’s food safety regulation”), fresh and dried herbs, jams and jellies (Cottage Law) handmade soaps, handmade wares, local arts and crafts, photography, and art. (No used items).
- All produce shall meet the requirements of local and State agencies. For commodities sold by weight, legal scales are required and must be approved by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services Bureau of Weights and Measures.
- Any and all items outside this list **must** gain approval from market personnel.
- Signage: Vendors are permitted professionally produced signage within their assigned space. Tastefully handwritten signs are acceptable. Signs must fit within designated vendor space. All display areas must be neat, attractive, and professional.
- Clean-up Requirements: Each vendor/grower must be responsible for cleaning their assigned area. Any spillage must be cleaned up immediately. Any trash or refuse discarded or left on market premises, or rights of way is the responsibility of the individual vendor to remove from premises. This includes trash or refuse discarded by vendor/grower ‘s customers.
