READ CAREFULLY

- I. Initial Rally Point
 - a. All golf carts participating shall be brought to Under the Palms Park, corner of 7th Street and Maryland, at **5:00pm CT**.
 - b. Golf carts on the east end of Mexico Beach may use city streets to drive their carts to Under the Palms Park to participate in Christmas parade.
 - c. Golf carts will NOT be allowed access on Highway 98 before or after the parade.**
- II. Line Up: Bay County Sheriff (lead), Golf Carts then, Mexico Beach Fire Engine (rear)
 - a. Route (approximately six miles through Mexico Beach, and lasting one (1) hour)
 - b. Bay County Sheriff's officers will place static roadblocks as necessary on Highway 98 to ensure parade participant safety.
 - c. The Parade will stop at tree lighting at Parker Park.
 - d. The Parade will start from the Under the Palms Park, being led by Bay County Sheriff's unit.
All Golf Carts will follow Bay County Sheriffs unit and not deviate from their set route.
- III. Return
 - a. Golf Carts will be escorted back to their homes by Bay County Sheriffs Unit after parade route has been completed.
 - b. Golf Carts not escorted home at the end of parade route will be escorted back to Under the Palms Park to be trailered and returned home.

316.193 Driving under the influence; penalties.—(1) A person is guilty of the offense of driving under the influence and is subject to punishment as provided in subsection (2) if the person is driving or in actual physical control of a vehicle within this state and:(a) The person is under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance set forth in s. 877.111, or any substance controlled under chapter 893, when affected to the extent that the person's normal faculties are impaired;(b) The person has a blood-alcohol level of 0.08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood; or(c) The person has a breath-alcohol level of 0.08 or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath.

316.1936 Possession of open containers of alcoholic beverages in vehicles prohibited: penalties. —

(1) As used in this section, the term:(a) "Open container" means any container of alcoholic beverage which is immediately capable of being consumed from, or the seal of which has been broken.
(b) "Road" means a way open to travel by the public, including, but not limited to, a street, highway, or alley. The term includes associated sidewalks, the roadbed, the right-of-way, and all culverts, drains, sluices, ditches, water storage areas, embankments, slopes, retaining walls, bridges, tunnels, and viaducts necessary for the maintenance of travel and all ferries used in connection therewith.(2)(a) It is unlawful and punishable as provided in this section for any person to possess an open container of an alcoholic beverage or consume an alcoholic beverage while operating a vehicle in the state or while a passenger in or on a vehicle being operated in the state.(b) It is unlawful and punishable as provided in this section for any person to possess an open container of an alcoholic beverage or consume an alcoholic beverage while seated in or on a motor vehicle that is parked or stopped within a road as defined in this section. Notwithstanding the prohibition contained in this section, passengers in vehicles designed, maintained, and used primarily for the transportation of persons for compensation and in motor homes are exempt.
